CRIS (Community Resources for Independent Seniors) recently held it's first Annual meeting, marking a milestone for the local group that evolved as a result of needs identified in the GCACC Senior Housing Feasibility Study.

Focus groups and surveys, as part of the study, outlined transportation and other supportive services needed in this area to help seniors live in their homes as long as possible.

CRIS launched CRIS-CAT (Cazenovia Area Transportation) in May 2010 to address the transportation need.

Steve Burrell has recruited over 30 wonderful volunteers who are providing over 10 rides per week for residents 55 and over, to doctor's appointments, shopping and social events. Volunteers are needed to meet the increasing number of requests for transportation.
